There is also a CPD course being introduced for the coaches – Kev will be sending out a link and the 0063lub needs 50% of coaches to complete this.

Steve – Please make sure that any parent who offers to help must have a CRC check as this is what the FA are looking out for and a club will be fined if they allow a parent to help in any way either on a match day or training without CRC.
